Skagit Valley College radio station to host Mount Vernon Citizenship Day

MOUNT VERNON, Wash. — KSVR 91.7 FM, Skagit Valley College's (SVC) radio station, will host the Mount Vernon Citizenship Day workshop on Saturday, April 27 in Charles Lewis Hall room 65, located at SVC's Mount Vernon Campus. Registration begins at 9:00 a.m.

Now in its 10th year, the annual workshop is organized by the American Immigration Lawyers Association, OneAmerica, Catholic Community Services of Skagit County, along with volunteers from Seattle, Mount Vernon, Bellingham, and Everett. The workshop offers legal services for the processing of U.S. Citizenship applications. Applicants can receive free legal counseling and may qualify for a low-income waiver of the \$625 federal filing fee.

Last year, over 100 individuals applied and not all could be reviewed in one day, so arriving early is highly encouraged. Those not able to have paperwork reviewed will be contacted for a later workshop. More than 70 applications will be processed at the April 27 workshop.

The application involves providing a range of historical and income verifications, so those interested should review the requirements as incomplete applications will not be processed.
